Investment Strategy from portfolio's prospectus

The investment seeks a combination of growth of capital, current income, growth of income and relatively low risk as compared with the stock market as a whole.

The fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets in common stocks. It invests mainly in a diverse group of common stocks of well-established companies, typically above \$5 billion in market capitalization, many of which have historically paid regular dividends. Up to 25% of the fund's assets may be invested in securities within a single industry. It may invest without limitation in foreign securities. Under normal circumstances, the fund invests predominantly in common stocks of U.S. companies.

Category Description: Large Blend

Large-blend funds have portfolios that are fairly representative of the overall stock market in size, growth rates, and price. They tend to invest across the spectrum of U.S. industries and owing to their broad exposure, the funds' returns are often similar to those of the S&P 500 Index.

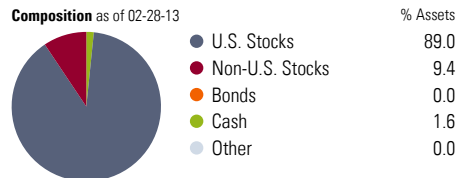

For each sub-account with at least a three-year history, Morningstar calculates a Morningstar Rating™ based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a sub-account's monthly performance (including the effects of any applicable sales charges, loads and redemption fees), placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. (Each share class is counted as a fraction of one sub-account within this scale and rated separately, which may cause slight variations in the distribution percentages.) The top 10% of the sub-accounts in an investment category receive 5 stars, 22.5% receive 4 stars, 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating is a weighted average of the sub-accounts' three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar rating metrics.
